## EXTENSION HIGH-BAY WAREHOUSE

The new high-bay warehouse unit in the B. Braun Melsungen AG distribution centre at the Pfieffewiesen site has gone into operation at the start of July

With a capacity of 10,000 pallets, it is an extension of the logistics section in Melsungen. Highest priority was given to the themes of ecological sustainability and energy efficiency. By recycling existing aluminium facade panels, the smelting, production and transport of new panels could be avoided. The deliberately resulting salt and pepper aesthetic is thus not only ecological and unique, but also lively in appearance. It also allows for an uncomplicated replacement of any panel at any time.

## TOPPING-OUT CEREMONY IN HAMBURG

After a year of construction the topping-out ceremony was celebrated at the beginning of April.

On a former barracks site in Hamburg-Alsterdorf, between Sengelmannstrasse and Suhrenkamp, the Gesellschaft fuer Wohnungs- und Gewerbebau Baden-Wuerttemberg AG (GWG) has developed new housing with a total of 309 rental apartments with two separate underground parking garages. The winning design was the result of a closed, urban-design-competition, that ORANGE BLU has won together with the structural engineering firm, Eckert Manthos Tagwerker.
