



Musik Academy

The new Music Academy was designed to integrate within existing buildings in the centre of the renowned musical town of Trossingen. The new facility provides additional rehearsal rooms for the Orchestra, ancient music and rhythm departments, as well as office areas for administration. It is constructed as a separate building with an underground connection to the Music Academy.

The compact three-storey structure was built in accordance with its specific functions: The foyer and the events office have panes of floor-to-ceiling glass which peel back diagonaly from the main street into the interior of the building. This expresses the building's public functions while making a visual connection with the existing Music Academy complex. The largest and tallest room of the Rhythm Department is designed as an obliquely ascending "head" with a large picture window that faces onto the main street. It's possible for passers-by to glimpse at what is happening inside the Music Academy.
